Misallocated payments will only be
corrected on a one-time basis.
Subsequent payment adjustments
will be subject to a \$25 admin fee
- Bill Payment with your financial institution

proof of payment

PRE-AUTHORIZED PAYMENT (2021)

Sign up for the Town's Property Tax
Pre-Authorized (Monthly) Payment Plan

- Your 2020 taxes must be paid in full by
4:30pm on July 2, 2020 to take part in this
plan for 2021
- If you are already on the plan, you do not
need to reapply for 2021
- Pay your 2021 taxes in 10 equal monthly
payments
- Payments run monthly from August 2020
to May 2021 on the 10th of each month

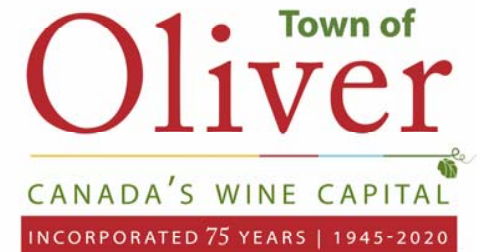

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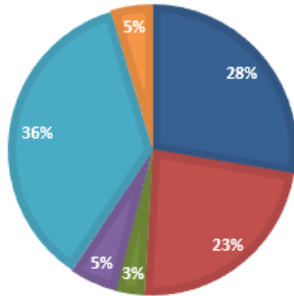

Your 2020 Taxes

In 2020 the municipal tax levy collected by the Town of Oliver on the average residential property will be \$2,247, allocated to the general municipal services as follows:

Penalty Dates

- 1% will be applied to the balance of current taxes unpaid after **July 2, 2020**
- a further 4% will be applied to the balance of current taxes unpaid after **September 30, 2020**

Commercial businesses

- 5% will be applied to current taxes unpaid after **September 30, 2020**

Property Tax Deferment Program

Home Owner Grant (HOG)



The Home Owner Grant is a Provincial Property Tax Assistance Program

There are two categories of grants:

- Basic Grant up to \$770
- Additional grant up to \$275 for a total of \$1,045
 - 65 and older or a person with disabilities

(see additional information on the reverse of your tax notice)

Did you Know?

HOGs must have been claimed by the tax deadline, of July 2, 2020, to avoid penalty and needs to be claimed each year

You can claim the HOG without paying your taxes

You can also claim your HOG online at www.oliver.ca. Town Services/Online Services

If your property taxes are paid through your mortgage company, you must still claim your HOG
