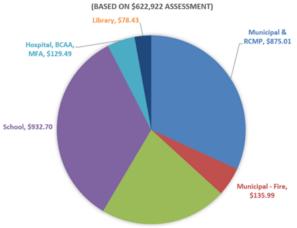

2023 TAX LEVY

Average Single Family Residential Home Assessments increased by 10.3% in 2023, from \$564,578 to \$622,922. If your property assessment increased by 10.3%, your taxes, including parcel taxes, will increase by approximately 5.9%. If your property assessment increased by less than 10.3%, your tax increase will be less than 5.9%. *

For 2023, Council approved an average 8.8% increase in municipal taxes, including RCMP and Fire, across all property classes. The 2023 increase is directed towards increased RCMP and Fire protection costs, along with general cost increases for other municipal services.

* Actual change in property taxes will depend upon the proportion of land and improvement assessment on your property.

HOME OWNERS GRANT

- Must apply each year
- Only one registered owner, who qualifies can apply
- Go to gov.bc.ca/homeownergrant to apply online
- To apply by phone, toll free 1 888.355.2700.
 *When you apply have your social insurance number and folio number ready
- Must be a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident of Canada
- Live in BC
- Occupy the residence as your principal residence
- Apply before the tax due date July 04, 2023 to avoid a 10% penalty

PROPERTY TAX DEFERMENT

- You may qualify to defer your taxes on your principal residence for the current tax year, if you are:
 - 55 years or older, a surviving spouse, or a person with disability, or
 - Financially support a dependent child with disability or under the age of 18
