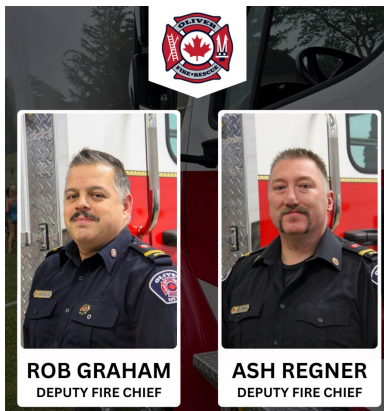

PROPERTY TAX INFORMATION AND DATES



Property taxes are due by July 2, 2024 with notices being sent in the mail in the last week of May.

To receive your tax notice by email, register for our online services before May 20th.

Remember to claim your Home Owners Grant before the deadline of July 2nd.

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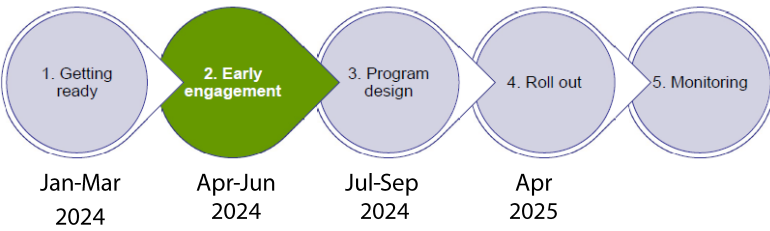

ORGANIC WASTE COLLECTION PROGRAM

The Town of Oliver is seeking residents' feedback and input on the implementation of Oliver's organic waste collection program. The findings will be shared in a public Council meeting in the summer of 2024.

Anticipated implementation and consultation timeline



The Town of Oliver is collaborating with partners to initiate an organic waste collection program for its solid waste collection customers. This initiative is crucial for extending the lifespan of the Oliver landfill, modernizing the Town's solid waste program, and aligning with a program already embraced by approximately 3.7 million British Columbia residents. Currently, the Town is gathering input to shape the final design of the organic waste collection program, which is tentatively scheduled for launch in April 2025.

SPRING CHIPPING SERVICES

Spring chipping services will once again be available to residents during the week of April 22nd, 2024.

Our public works crews will be collecting branches with diameters ranging from 1/2 inch up to 4 inches.

To efficiently manage time, crews will allocate a maximum of 10 minutes of chipping per residence. Therefore, residents are advised to make their own arrangements for disposing of large volumes of chipping items.

To assist our crews, please neatly bundle materials to maximize the volume that can be chipped within the designated time limit. Bundles should be placed exclusively on the boulevard as crews will not enter private property.

Please pay special attention that all materials are free from dirt, metal (such as nails or wire) and plastic. Contaminated items will not be collected for chipping.

Please ensure branches are placed curbside by 7:00 a.m. on Monday, April 22nd, 2024.

TOWN WORKING GROUP ESTABLISHED

The Town of Oliver is working with local doctors on a new physician recruitment and retention initiative. Local doctors requested to work with the Town to encourage medical students completing education placements in the local community to consider making Oliver their permanent place of residence and medical practice when they have completed their medical training. The goal of the Oliver Physician Recruitment and Retention Working Group will be to bring together key community partners and community members to identify ways to encourage students to start practicing medicine in Oliver on a permanent basis after completion of their education program.



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
