The shutoff date will be published once set by Council.

Late irrigation is charged at **\$2.24/acre per day** of usage.

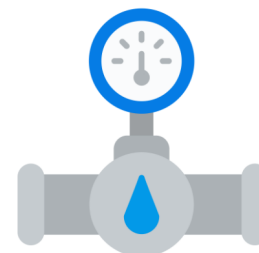

OLIVER AND DISTRICT RECREATION UPDATE

Construction on the **Oliver & District Arena Rehabilitation** project started in the spring of 2024. The project includes replacing the ice slab and dasher board system, installing an energy recovery system, upgrading refrigeration controls, ensuring life safety code compliance, and renovating dressing rooms, washrooms, and the kitchen for accessibility.



Oliver and District Recreation has created a **Recreation Master Plan** that sets out the vision and priorities for recreation services and capital investments over the next 10-20 years in collaboration with the Town of Oliver, Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen, and the Osoyoos Indian Band.
